CULLMAN COUNTY COMMISSION - Cullman County now has a Chairman and FOUR (4) Associate Commissioners. This change was implemented and approved by legislators. All four Associate Commissioners would appear on the ballot and voted for in the Primary Election **EXCEPT:**

District 1 and District 3 are unopposed; therefore, they will not appear on the Primary Ballot. District 2 and District 4 will appear on the Primary Ballot May 24, 2022.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES – Cullman County will now be represented by State Representative Districts 11, 12, and 14. This is a result of redistricting by our legislators brought about after the 2020 Census. House of Representative District 9 is no longer in Cullman County.

ELECTION INTEGRITY – Cullman County has great election workers with the best intent and the utmost integrity. Election Workers are one of the reasons for fair and honest elections in Cullman County. The Board of Registrars, Circuit Clerk, County IT Department, County Commission, County Custodians, Sheriff, and Probate Office Employees plus many others all play a vital role in and with the election process.
